Students may choose one of three tracks: Language, Culture, or Archaeology. The Language and Cultures tracks require a two- or three-quarter NELC civilization sequence which can be taken on campus or in one of the Study Abroad programs focusing on the Middle East.

• **Language Track**

NOTE: Students using a NELC sequence to satisfy the general education requirement in civilization studies may seek approval from the department to substitute additional language course work in place of the civilization requirement in the minor
